## Recognize. Sexual assault is unwanted, non-consensual sexual contact ranging from unwanted sexual touching to unwanted penetration When someone is sexually assaulted, it is often by someone they know, the majority of sexual assaults on a college campus fall into this category. Respond. Listen and take the situation seriously Avoid questioning and judging the survivor Address safety and validate feelings Inform your friend they have rights and options Support your friend in doing what they decide is best for them Reach out.
